1.1.1 Name of Work:

Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC) Ltd. invites Open e-Tenders from eligible applicants, who fulfill qualification criteria as stipulated in Clause 1.1.3 of NIT, for the work, “Contract IT/ILL15: For 5/10 Mbps Internet Leased Line connectivity (1:1 uncompressed and unshared) at various DMRC project site offices across Delhi-NCR”. The required Internet Leased Line connectivity is for a total of 13 offices across Delhi-NCR with 10 Mbps ILL for 05 offices & 5 Mbps ILL for 08 offices.

1.1.3 QUALIFICATION CRITERIA:

1.1.3.1 Eligible Applicants:

- i. The tenders for this contract would be considered only from **Indian tenderers** (proprietorship firms, partnerships firms, companies, corporations) who meet requisite eligibility criteria prescribed in the sub-clauses of Clause 1.1.3 of NIT. JV or Consortium are not allowed. Liasioning (if required) with other firm(s) for obtaining point to point connectivity between ISP node and DMRC shall be the responsibility of quoting firm
- ii. A tenderer shall submit only one bid, tenderer who submits or participates in more than one bid will cause all of the proposals disqualified in which the tenderer has participated. The bidder is prohibited from sub-contracting or sub-letting of the work to any other agency.
- iii. Tenderers shall not have a conflict of interest. Tenderers found to have a conflict of interest shall be disqualified. Tenderers shall be considered to have a conflict of interest with one or more parties in this bidding process, if:
 - (a) a tenderer has been engaged by the Employer to provide consulting services for the preparation related to procurement for implementation of the project;
 - (b) a tenderer's associate(s)/affiliate(s) (inclusive of parent firms) mentioned above; or
 - (c) a tenderer lends, or temporarily seconds its personnel to firms or organizations which are engaged in consulting services for the preparation related to procurement for implementation of the project, if the personnel would be involved in any capacity on the same project.

1.1.3.2 Minimum Eligibility Criteria:

A. Work Experience:

The tenderers will be qualified only if they have experience of installation of Internet Leased Line connectivity (1:1 uncompressed and unshared) in any organization in India for which following details duly authenticated by the client are to be submitted:

- (a) Name of Organization where work done
- (b) Customer contact Name, email and Phone Number
- (c) Scope undertaken by Applicant (indicate bandwidth details also)
- (d) Certificate from at least two organizations for satisfactory operational use for the last 2 years from the date of completion.

B. Financial Standing: The tenderers will be qualified only if they have minimum financial capabilities as below:

- 1) **T2 - Profitability:** Profit before Tax should be Positive in at least 2 (two) year, out of the last five audited financial years.

Notes:

- a. Financial data for last five audited financial years has to be submitted by the tenderer in **Appendix- 10 of FOT**. The financial data in the prescribed format shall be certified by Chartered Accountant with his stamp and signature in original

C. Bid Capacity Criteria:

The tenderers will be qualified only if they have completed work(s) during last 5 years ending **31.03.2014** as given below:

At least one project for implementation of internet bandwidth of capacity 75 Mbps or more.

OR

Two project for implementation of internet bandwidth of capacity 40 Mbps or more.

OR

Three project for implementation of internet bandwidth of capacity 30 Mbps or more.

Notes:

- (i) The tenderer shall submit details of works executed by them in the Performa prescribed in **Appendix-11 of FOT** for the works to be considered for qualification of work experience criteria.
- (ii) The Contractor shall provide documentary proof such as completion certificates/performance certificate from client showing satisfactory performance of similar works wherein following details are to be given:
 - (a) Name of Organization where work done
 - (b) Customer contact Name, email and Phone Number
 - (c) Scope of work undertaken by the Applicant
 - (d) Actual completion cost
 - (e) Actual date of completion
 - (f) Certificate of satisfactory operational use, minimum for last 2 years from the date of completion (with name of Project).

D. Additional Requirements of Eligibility:

- (i) The Tenderers will be qualified if they have not been blacklisted or deregistered by any central / state government department or public sector undertaking and also that none of their work was rescinded by the DMRC after award of contract during last 5 years due to non performance.
- (ii) The bidder should be the Tier 1 national ISP and should have a valid Category "A" ISP license for at least 3 years from Govt. of India (Attach a copy of license).
- (iii) The tenderer shall submit copy of Permanent Account Number (PAN/TIN) issued by Income Tax Department.
- (iv) ISP must have DOT license to set up and operate International gateways.
- (v) ISP should have their own/direct access to international gateway in India, for providing Internet bandwidth, which should be connected onto international fiber systems only (not on satellite), Vendor must provide the certificate thereof.
- (vi) Should have at least one International Point of Presence for peering with Tier 1 carriers and local peering within India with at least one other ISP.
- (vii) The quotation should clearly indicate the different components of the total charges- recurring (annual) and non-recurring (one time) for bandwidth and equipment supplied

1.1.3.3 The tender submission of tenderers, who do not qualify the minimum eligibility criteria & bid capacity criteria stipulated in the clauses 1.1.3.2 A, B, C & D above, shall not be considered for further evaluation and therefore rejected. The mere fact that the tenderer is qualified as mentioned in sub clause 1.1.3.2 shall not imply that his bid shall automatically be accepted.

The same should contain all technical data as required for consideration of tender prescribed in the ITT.

- 1.9 The tenderers may obtain further information/ clarification, if any, in respect of these tender documents from the office of **AGM/IT**, Delhi Metro Rail Corporation, 'B' Wing, 4th floor, Metro Bhawan, Fire Brigade Lane, Barakhamba Road, New Delhi –110 001.
- 1.10 The intending tenderers must be registered on e-tendering portal www.tenderwizard.com/DMRC. Those who are not registered on the e-tendering portal shall be required to get registered beforehand. If needed they can be imparted training on 'online tendering process'. After registration, the tenderer will get user id and password. On login, tenderer can participate in tendering process and can witness various activities of the process.
- 1.11 The authorized signatory of intending tenderer, as per Power of Attorney (POA), must have valid **class-III** digital signature. The tender document can only be downloaded or uploaded using Class-III digital signature of the authorized signatory.
- 1.12 Tender submissions will be made online after uploading the mandatory scanned documents towards cost of tender documents such as Demand Draft or Pay Order or Banker's Cheque from a Scheduled commercial bank based in India and towards Tender Security such as Bank Guarantee or Demand Draft or Pay Order or Banker's Cheque from a Scheduled commercial bank based in India and other documents as stated in the tender document.
- 1.13 Late tenders (received after date and time of submission of bid) shall not be accepted under any circumstances.
- 1.14 Tenders shall be valid for a period of 180 days (both days inclusive i.e. the date of submission of tender and the last date of period of validity of the tender) from the date of submission of Tenders and shall be accompanied with a tender security of the requisite amount as per clause 4.0 of ITT.
- 1.15 DMRC reserves the right to accept or reject any or all proposals without assigning any reasons. No tenderer shall have any cause of action or claim against the DMRC for rejection of his proposal.
