

SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

1.0 TENDER DOCUMENT COST shall be Rs 21,000/-

2.0 EMD AMOUNT shall be 2,53,800/-

3.0 VALIDITY OF BANK GUARANTEE FOR EMD

Bank Guarantee for EMD should be valid for minimum 180 days.

4.0 QUALIFYING REQUIREMENTS OF TENDERERS

The tenderer should be TEC/RDSO approved for HDPE pipe/coupler

5.0 VALIDITY OF OFFER

In case of Open tender, the offer shall be kept valid for acceptance for a minimum period of 180 days from the date of opening of the tender.

6.0 WARRANTIES

Warranty shall be 18 months from the date of installation or 24 months from the date of supply, whichever is earlier.

7.0 Test Procedure

1. As per TEC specification No. TEC/GR/TX/CDS-008/03/March-11, acceptance test as mentioned below is required for HDPE duct:
 - a) Tensile Strength & Elongation(Clause 4.5)
 - b) Reversion Test (Clause 4.6)
 - c) Environmental Stress Crack Resistance (Clause 4.7)
 - d) Impact Strength (Clause 4.8)
 - e) Crush Resistance (Clause 4.9)
 - f) Oxidation Induction Test (Clause 4.13)
 - g) Hydraulic Characteristics (Clause 4.14)
 - h) Internal Co-efficient of Friction (Clause 4.15)
2. The above mentioned test (C), ESCR test report shall be submitted for 96 hrs.
3. Third party testing for acceptance test shall be got done by the supplier at his own cost from TSEC/RITES. Cost of all such test Inspection shall be borne by the supplier. The supplier shall ensure the quality of material as per the specifications. Material Testing Certificate (MTC) shall be submitted with every batch. All related certificates and test reports shall be submitted to DMRC for review. Cost of all such tests /inspections shall be borne by the supplier.
4. DMRC may choose to witness above mentioned tests.

5. Type test is not required, if previously independently witness test have been successfully carried out. Test report for the same shall be submitted.

7.0 Penalty Clause—The faulty cable drums shall be replaced within 21 days and a fine of 1% of the drum cost shall be imposed for the first drum, of 2% for second drum and hence forth till a maximum of 10% per drum.

8.0 Consignee: ED/S&T/P-I,ED/S&T/P-II & CSTE/P

9.0 PAYMENT TERMS: 100% payment shall be made after receipt and acceptance of material at DMRC site.

Note:

10.0 Tenderers are required to submit Tender Document Cost for the amount mentioned in the Special Conditions of Contract, before submission of their offer, and failure to do so shall render the offer liable to be rejected. Tenderers has to submit the cost of tender document Through a Banker's Cheque (BC), Pay Order (PO), Demand Draft (DD) issued by Nationalized or Scheduled Commercial Banks in favour of Delhi Metro Rail Corporation Ltd., New Delhi.

11.0 EMD in the form as mentioned in clause no.4.0 of instruction to tenderer of tender may be also be submitted before opening of tender.

12.0 Cost of tender and EMD as mentioned at s.no. 1 & 2 may be submitted in the office of the Controller of Stores, Delhi Metro Rail Corporation Ltd., Metro Bhawan, Fire Brigade Lane, Barakhamba Road, New Delhi-110001", duly indicating the Tender Number and Tender Closing Date on the reverse of the instruments of before opening of tender.
