**NOTICE INVITING TENDER**

**1.1 GENERAL**

Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC) Ltd. invites **sealed e-open tenders in TWO PACKETS SYSTEM (Technical and Financial)** from the eligible tenderes as per tender **clause 1.2** of NIT for **"Electrical Work for Installation Fire Pumps at different metro stations"**.

## 1.2 Eligibility Criteria (Mandatory documents)

### 1.2.1 Work Experiences:

- a. The firm should have successfully completed at least

One single work of similar nature of at least 80% value of contract or two similar work each of at least 50% value of contract and 3 works each of at least 40% each value of contract in Govt./Semi Govt organization/PSU during last **five** years. (work completed up to 30 Sep 2015 shall only be considered)

**Similar nature of work means:** Supply, Installations, Testing & Commissioning of Electrical Work i.e. Panels/ Wiring/ Cabling etc. in Govt/Semi Govt organization/PSU during the last **five** years ending on 30 Sep 2015.

#### NOTE:

1. Successful completed portion of ongoing works shall also be considered for qualifying the eligible criteria.
2. Following documents shall be considered for evaluating the criteria of work experience:
  - a. The tenderer shall submit details of successfully completed similar works executed by them in the performa given in **Form T-II** for evaluation of their tender offer regarding **Clause 1.2.1.a**. Documentary proof such as completion certificates from client clearly indicating the nature/ scope of work, actual completion cost and actual date of completion for such work should be submitted.

### 1.2.2 Financial Standings -

- a. Tenderer should have average Annual Turnover of last three audited financial years not less than **Rs. 41,08,238/-** (80% of total estimated cost of work).
- b. Tenderer shall submit last three years (year 2012-2013, 2013-2014, 2014-2015) audited financial statement duly attested by certified CA to work out net worth. **The net worth must be positive.**

Financial data for latest last three audited financial years has to be submitted by the tenderer in **Form T-V** along with audited balance sheets. The financial data in the prescribed format i.e. Form T-V shall be certified by Chartered Accountant with his stamp bearing his membership number and signature. In case audited balance sheet of the last financial year is not made available by the bidder, he has to submit an affidavit certifying that 'the balance sheet has actually not been audited so far'. In such a case the financial data of previous audited financial years will be taken into consideration for evaluation.

- c. Attested copies of the PAN under income Tax Act, PF registration certificate, and ESI Registration certificate, VAT/Sales Tax / Service Tax Registration Certificate as applicable. "As per Delhi VAT Act, the party who is executing work in Delhi has to have registration with VAT authorities of Delhi. If a tenderer is outside Delhi intends to participate in DMRC tender, he can be permitted provided he gives an undertaking to the fact that he will get himself registered with Delhi VAT authorities, in the event of issue of Letter of acceptance to the tenderer and shall submit registration number before claiming initial advance or first payment whichever is earlier. In the absence of registration detail with Delhi Sales Tax / Delhi VAT Department payment shall not be released."
- d. Tenderer must not have been black listed or deregistered by any Govt or Public sector undertaking during last 5 years. The contractor has to submit an undertaking on Rs. 10/- stamp paper duly attested by Notary in format enclosed in **Annexure -D**.
- e. Tenderer must not have involved in any litigation/ arbitration or no case pending in any court against them during the last 5 year. The contractor has to submit an undertaking on Rs. 10/- stamp paper duly attested by Notary in format enclosed in **Annexure -E**.

- 1.2.3 The tender submission of bidders, who do not qualify the minimum eligibility criteria stipulated in the **clauses 1.2** above, shall not be considered for further evaluation and considered rejected. The mere fact that the bidder is qualified as mentioned in sub clause

shall not imply that his bid shall automatically be accepted. The same shall be subject to the data as required for consideration of tender prescribed in the ITT.

The mere fact that the tenderer is Pre-qualified as shall not imply that his bid shall automatically be accepted. The same should contain all Financial & other details as required for the consideration of tender.

- 1.2.4 The tenderers may obtain further information in respect of these tender documents from the office of Sr. Deputy General Manager /E&M office, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, C-Wing, Metro Bhawan, Fire Brigade lane, Barakhamba Road, New Delhi-110001.
- 1.2.5 The intending bidders must be registered on e-tendering portal [www.tenderwizard.com/DMRC](http://www.tenderwizard.com/DMRC). Those who are not registered on the e-tendering portal shall be required to get registered beforehand. If needed they can be imparted training on 'online tendering process'. After registration the tenderer will get user id and password. On login tenderer can participate in tendering process and can witness various activities of the process.
- 1.2.6 The authorized signatory of intending bidder, as per Power of Attorney (POA), must have valid class-III digital signature. The tender document can only be downloaded or uploaded using Class-III digital signature of the authorized signatory.
- 1.2.7 Tender submissions will be made online after uploading the mandatory scanned documents towards cost of tender documents such as Demand Draft or Pay Order or Banker's Cheque from a Scheduled commercial bank based in India and towards Tender Security such as Bank Guarantee or Demand Draft or Pay Order or Banker's Cheque from a Scheduled commercial bank based in India and other documents as stated in the tender document.
- 1.2.8 Tenderer is cautioned that the tender containing any material deviation from the tender document which consists of NIT, Instructions to tenderes, General conditions of contract, Special conditions of contract, Bill of quantities is liable to be summarily rejected as non-responsive.
- 1.2.9 Tenders shall be valid for a period of as per **ITT clause 11** from the date of submission of Tenders and shall be accompanied with a tender security of the requisite amount as per **ITT clause 12**.
- 1.2.10 DMRC reserves the right to accept or reject any or all proposals without assigning any reasons. No bidder shall have any cause of action or claim against the DMRC for rejection of his proposal.
- 1.2.11 Bidders shall note that the maximum file size that can be uploaded is 5 MB. All the uploaded files in tender submission should be named properly and arrange systematically.

The contractor shall execute the work i.e. **“Electrical Work for Installation Fire Pumps at different metro stations”**.

**2.1 Brief Scope**

This contract is for **“Electrical Work for Installation Fire Pumps at different metro stations”**.

- Supply, Installation, Testing & Commissioning of Electrical Panels
- Supply, Installation, Testing & Commissioning of different size of electrical cables
- Supply, Installation, Testing & Commissioning of different size of cable trays
- Supply, Installation, Testing & Commissioning of electrical accessories i.e. MCCB, Contactors, Overload Relay, Timer etc.
- And other associated works

**NOTE:-** The work may be carried out during revenue/ non revenue i.e. 24X7 hours as required as per site condition. Scope of work shall also include the followings.

- De-mobilization, clearing of all temporary works after completion of work.
- Any other item of work as may be required to be carried out for completing the work under this contract in all respects in accordance with the provisions of the contract and/or to ensure the safety of installation during and after execution.
- Handing over the commissioned system
- The contractor may be asked to carry out the modification/ augmentation work, anywhere in the metro network in Delhi NCR.

**INTERFACE WORKS**

- The contractor shall be required & responsible to have a very close interface with the Operation, Civil, S&T department or as required of O&M wing of DMRC.

**2.2** DMRC is an ISO-14001 & OHSAS 18001 certified Organization for Environment, Health & safety. The work is to be carried out as per International Norms/Standards and in such a manner that all premises always look Neat & Clean. Similarly, the waste disposal is also carried out in totally sealed manner without affecting the Environment.

## **SECTION 3**

### **TENDER PRICES AND SCHEDULE OF PAYMENT**

#### **3.1.1 Tender Prices**

- a. Unless explicitly stated otherwise in the Tender Documents, the contractor shall be responsible for the whole works, based on the Bill of Quantities and payment shall be as per accepted rates based on the activities carried out as in the Schedule of work.
- b. The rate quoted by the tenderer shall be inclusive of all duties, taxes, fees, octroi and other levies, tools & tackles, materials, labour to & fro, transportation of material and labour charges etc.

#### **3.1.2 Schedule of Payment**

- a) The payment shall be made once in two months as per accepted rates for actual work executed satisfactorily at site duly certified by DMRC representative.
- b) Payment shall be subjected to deduction of all T.D.S as per applicable law.
