1.1.1 Name of Work:

Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC) Ltd. invites Open e-Tenders on International Competitive Basis (ICB) from eligible applicants from all countries and all areas, who fulfill qualification criteria as stipulated in section III of bid documents, for the work,

1.1.4 QUALIFICATION CRITERIA:

A A. Eligibility Criteria

Since majority of Turnouts in the present tender are for Standard Gauge, the Bidder shall furnish documentary evidence to demonstrate that it meets the following experience requirement(s):

Supply of Standard Gauge canted Turnouts of 1 in 7, 1 in 9, or similar with a minimum quantity in last Seven years and are in service in established Metro / Railway system.

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| (a) | Turnouts for Ballastless Track | = | 100 sets |
| (b) | Scissor cross over for Ballastless Track | = | 6 sets |
| (c) | Turnouts for Ballasted Track | = | 100 sets |
| (d) | At least 25% of such supplies in (a), (b) & (c) above should be of UIC 60 <u>or 60 E1</u> rail profile. | | |

- I) Experience and Technical Capacity: - The bidder shall furnish documentary evidence to demonstrate that it meets the following experience requirements.
- (II) Bidder shall furnish year wise and consignee wise details of supply during last seven years.
- (III) The bidder shall furnish the details of supplies made for the goods being procured in this contract. Details should include a performance certificate which should include purchase order details, name of purchaser, the railway projects/ MRTS Project, where used / being used, the design speed and axle load of the section, quantity of rails supplied and period of supply. The details of address, contract person, fax / e-mail is also to be furnished. In absence of the above statement / details, offer will be summarily rejected.

- II. (a) A Tenderer and in case of JV or Consortium, all partners constituting the Tenderer may be from any country and all areas.
- (b) A tenderer shall submit only one bid in the same tendering process, either individually as a tenderer or as a partner of a JV. A tenderer who submits or participates in, more than one bid will cause all of the proposals in which the tenderer has participated to be disqualified. No tenderer can be a subcontractor while submitting a bid individually or as a partner of a JV in the same bidding process. A tenderer, if acting in the capacity of subcontractor in any bid, may participate in more than one bid, but only in that capacity.
- III. Tenderers shall not have a conflict of interest. All Tenderers found to have a conflict of interest shall be disqualified. Tenderers shall be considered to have a conflict of interest with one or more parties in this bidding process, if:
- a) a tenderer has been engaged by the Employer to provide consulting services for the preparation related to procurement for on implementation of the project;
- b) a tenderer is any associates/affiliates (inclusive of parent firms) mentioned in subparagraph (a) above; or
- c) a tenderer lends, or temporarily seconds its personnel to firms or organisations which are engaged in consulting services for the preparation related to procurement for on implementation of the project, if the personnel would be involved in any capacity on the same project.
- IV. A firm, who has purchased the tender document in their name, can submit the tender either as individual firm or in joint venture/Consortium.
- V. The applicant shall submit user certificate for successful completion as on submission date of tender, failure to submit would result in disqualification.
- VI. The supplier will submit user certificate for the supply of ~~Rails~~ **Turnouts** mentioned in clause 1.1.4 (A) along with their performance. The certificate should contain all the details, so that it can be established that supplier have experience of supplying the ~~HH-Rails~~ **Turnouts** required for DMRC work.
- VII (a) DMRC/ any Central / State government department / public sector undertaking / other government entity or local body must not have banned business with the tenderer (including any member in case of JV/Consortium) as on the date of tender submission.
- (b) Also no contract of the tenderer of the value more than 10% of NIT cost of work, executed either individually or in a JV/Consortium, should have been rescinded / terminated by DMRC/any Central or State Govt. Department / Public Sector Undertaking / Other Govt. entry or local body after award during last 3 years (from the last day of the previous month of tender submission) due to non-performance of the tenderer or any of JV/Consortium members. The tenderer should submit undertaking to this effect in – Form No. 8 to Section IV (Bidding Forms).
