For Example Otis India Participating as a sole bidder with our overseas factory as a subcontractor for supply, there is no requirement of a consortium agreement between us, whereas, the above said clause in your revised EOI is contradictory to our earlier discussion and understanding.</p> <p>As our factory will not form a consortium arrangement under lease model for a such long period, we request you to amend this clause, deleting subcontractor to be a member of consortium, allowing Otis India to participate as sole bidder with our overseas factory as our subcontractor for supply of equipment. Our overseas factory, appointed as subcontractor, will duly fulfill the eligibility criteria as per EOI</p>	Please refer Addendum No. - 1 of Revised EOI "L&E".

Bidders participating as a individual or Consortium with their factory need not to submit Parent Company Undertaking and parent Company Guarantee Like Otis India Participating as a sole bidder with our overseas factory as a subcontractor need not to submit Parent Company Undertaking and parent Company Guarantee, at EOI stage. Hope our understanding is correct</p>	<p>The Parent Company Guarantee and Parent Company Undertaking are not required during EOI Stage for the companies meeting eligibility criteria based on their own documents / records / credentials.</p> <p>However, Parent Company Guarantee and Parent Company Undertaking will have to be submitted during RFP Stage and an Undertaking regarding this, is to be submitted with EOI in the format provided as 'Annexure – III D' in Addendum No. - 1 of Revised EOI "L&E".</p>
